The Stewpot provides assistance to qualifying individuals in person on a first-come, first serve basis. Appointments are made at the front desk by the intake coordinator each weekday at 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. for same day morning and afternoon appointments (except holidays). The Stewpot cannot provide casework services or make appointments over the telephone.

Alcohol and Drug Counseling - Clients may participate in Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous meetings weekdays from 10.30 am-11.30 am.

Art Classes-Clients may participate in art classes Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 9.00 am-11.30 am. Registration for new art participants takes place on Friday mornings at 9:30 am.

Bible Readings and Discussions-Clients may participate in Bible readings and discussions Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from 9.00 am-10.00 am.

Casework Assistance - Casework services is open weekdays from 8.00 am-11.30 am and from 1.00 pm-3.45 pm (Tuesdays from 8.00 am-11.30 am and from 1.00 pm-2.45 pm.) Appointments are made at the front desk at 8:00 am & 1:00 pm for same day morning or afternoon appointments on a first come, first serve basis.

Community Ministries Scholarships-Clients who participated in Saturday School and Venturing Crew may apply for college scholarships.

Dental Clinic-Homeless clients may receive dental care from Community Dental Care staff weekdays from 8.00 am-11.30 am and from 1.00 pm-3.45 pm. Service is limited to the first 5 people who *present documentation from a shelter indicating that they are homeless. Appointments are generally required for return visits.*

Eye Clinic - Eye care service is limited to the first 5 people who sign-up at 8:00 am each Wednesday and 1:00 pm on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Wednesday of the month.

Identification Cards-Clients may receive Stewpot photograph identification cards Mondays from 8.00 am-10.00 am. *Clients must present acceptable vital records to get a Stewpot identification card.*

Mail Services-Clients may pick up mail weekdays from 11.00 am-11.30 am and from 1.30 pm-2.30 pm. *Clients must present an acceptable form of photograph identification to pick up their mail.*

Meals - The Stewpot serves 3 meals daily, seven days a week at the Second Chance Café located at the Bridge homeless assistance center located three block north of The Stewpot. Breakfast is served 7:00 8:30 am. Lunch 11:30 - 1:00 pm and Dinner 6:00 - 7:00.

Medical Clinic-Clients may receive medical care. Days and times vary, but doctors announce their arrival each week. The Parkland HOMES Van is available for medical services 9-11:30 bi-weekly on Mondays and 9:00 - 11:30 every Wednesday.

Peer Mentoring-Clients may meet with caseworkers for counseling, information, and or referrals.

Representative Payee Program-Clients may meet with rep payees for financial management if they receive Social Security Disability Income or Social Security Supplemental Income and are required to have such relationships. 5 referral is required from a

Restrooms & Water Fountain - Clients may use the restrooms and water fountain in the main room from 8.00 am-12.30 pm and from 1.00 pm-3.30 pm (Tuesdays from 8.00 am-12.30 pm and from 1.00 pm-2.45 pm.) Soap and toilet paper are available at the front desk.

Saturday School - City Park Elementary School students may participate in educational and recreational activities each Saturday, when school is in session, from 8.30 am-12.30 pm.

Seating - Clients may sit in the main room weekdays from 8.00 am-11.30 am and from 1.30 pm-3.45 pm (Tuesdays from 8.00 am-11.30 am and from 1.30 pm-2.45 pm.)

Social Service Agencies - Clients may meet with representatives from a variety of social service agencies such as Community Dental Care, Dallas County Department of Health and Human Services, Dallas MetroCare, Legal Aid of NorthWest Texas, Parkland HOMES medical services, Epilepsy Clinic, and Welcome House. See Stewpot Services Schedule.

Stewpot Transitional Employment Program (STEP) - Clients may meet with caseworkers about receiving help with applications, clothing, Community Voice Mail, DART passes, interview training, resumes, and supports while searching for jobs.

Street Zine - Clients may vend Street Zine, a newspaper that creates direct economic opportunity for the benefit of people living in poverty. Orientation for new vendors is announced in the main room each K YXbYgXUm at %30 pm.

Summer Day Camp - City Park Elementary School students may participate in educational and recreational activities each summer, when school is not in session.

Summer Visiting Youth Program - Youth groups may stay at the Stewpot and volunteer at a variety of Dallas' social service agencies each week of each summer.

Texas Department of Public Safety Driver Licenses and Identification Cards -Clients may meet with caseworkers about receiving financial assistance for Texas Department of Public Safety Driver Licenses or Identification Cards. *Service is first come-first serve and limited to the first 10 people daily.*

Venturing Crew -Youth may participate in educational and recreational activities affiliated with the Boy Scouts of America each Wednesday, when school is in session, from 6.00 pm-8.30 pm.

Vital Records - Clients may meet with caseworkers about receiving financial assistance for vital records such as birth certificates. *Service is first come-first serve and limited to the first 10 people daily.*
